AIM

BACKGROUND

Section 284 of the Municipal Act, 2001, requires the Treasurer to provide an annual itemized statement of remuneration and expenses paid in the previous year to Council and other Council appointees by March 31st. The statement must also indicate the authorizing by-law, resolution or statutory provision.
