AIM

To obtain Council approval to award a tender for the sanitary sewer upsizing on Pattullo Avenue from Ridgeway Road to Jack Ross Avenue.

BACKGROUND

Tenders for this project closed on Thursday, May 22, 2025. Five (5) tender submissions were received. The three (3) lowest bid amounts (including HST) were as follows:

- Sierra Infrastructure Inc., Woodstock, Ontario.....\$1,385,512.10
- Brantford Engineering and Construction Ltd., Brantford, Ontario.....\$1,440,543.78
- Oxford Civil Group Inc., Woodstock, Ontario.....\$1,487,318.10

According to the City's purchasing policy, Council must approve any tender award in excess of \$750,000.00.

COMMENTS

The 2025-2029 Capital Budget allocated \$3,377,000 (11166) for sanitary sewer replacement and repair. Included in this is \$1,925,000 for the sanitary sewer upsizing on Pattullo Avenue from Ridgeway Road to Jack Ross Avenue. Based on the low bid, the total County cost is \$1,247,696.56 (inclusive of non-refundable HST). The low bid is within the budgeted amount.

Sierra Infrastructure Inc. is a local firm and has completed numerous road reconstruction projects for the City of Woodstock. Staff is recommending award of this project to this firm. Subject to Council's approval, construction is anticipated to commence in summer 2025, weather permitting.
