Dear Members of City Council,

We are writing as residents and active members of the Woodstock community to formally request the installation of a pedestrian crosswalk at the intersection of Bysham Park Drive and Lansdowne Avenue.

This intersection currently lacks adequate pedestrian infrastructure, despite being a high-traffic area. There is a Woodstock Transit bus stop at this location, yet there is no safe, designated way for riders—particularly those crossing from the north side of Lansdowne—to access the sidewalk on Bysham Park Drive. This poses a significant safety risk for all pedestrians, and is especially difficult for community members who are elderly or have disabilities.

Many of us travel this route regularly between WDDS and Movement Church, participating in a variety of programs and recreational activities. Local businesses in the area also draw foot traffic, further increasing the need for safe pedestrian access.

We respectfully request that the City install a clearly marked crosswalk at this location, complete with flashing lights and signage to alert drivers. This addition would not only enhance safety but also demonstrate Woodstock's commitment to accessibility and community well-being.
