Re: 2023 Downtown Woodstock Summer StreetFest- AMENDED Request for Street Closures

On behalf of the Board of Management of the Downtown Woodstock Business Improvement Area, I submit the following request for council's approval.

Due to construction at Wilson and Henry and Wellington and Ingersoll we are no longer able to close Dundas Street from Wellington to Beale due to detours. The BIA requests City Council facilitate the temporary closing of Dundas Street and Simcoe Street for the BIA's annual summer festival, "StreetFest 2023". The closure of Simcoe Street is required to include those displaced between Wellington and Beale.

Event Dates are Friday, July 21 to Sunday July 23, 2023.

The BIA requests that the following streets be closed to vehicular traffic from 7:00AM Friday, July 21st through to 5:00PM on Sunday, July 23rd.

- 1. Dundas Street from Vansittart Avenue to Wellington
- 2. Simcoe Street from Finkle Street to Reeve with no through traffic sign at Peel Street
- 3. Light Street from Dundas to Hunter
- 4. Graham Street from Dundas to Hunter
- 5. Riddell Street from Dundas to Adelaide
- 6. Brock Street from Dundas to Simcoe
- 7. Perry Street Closed from Dundas to Simcoe
