

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF WOODSTOCK

BY-LAW NUMBER 9612-23

A by-law to provide for the temporary closing of certain streets – 2023 Streetfest.

WHEREAS Section 27(1) of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25, as amended thereto, provides that a municipality may pass by-laws in respect of a highway only if it has jurisdiction over the highway;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the City of Woodstock deems it desirable to temporarily close certain streets for the purpose of conducting the ‘**2023 Summer Streetfest**’ event;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the City of Woodstock enacts as follows:

1. That the following highways or portions of highways shall be temporarily closed from 7:00 a.m. Friday July 21st, to 5:00 p.m. on Sunday July 23rd, 2023, for the purpose of conducting the ‘**2023 Summer Streetfest**’ event.
 - Dundas Street from Vansittart Avenue to Wellington Street
 - Simcoe Street from Finkle Street to Peel Street with no through traffic sign at Peel Street
 - Light Street from Dundas Street to Hunter Street
 - Graham Street from Dundas Street to Hunter Street
 - Riddell Street from Dundas Street to Adelaide Street
 - Brock Street from Dundas Street to Simcoe Street
 - Perry Street from Dundas Street to Simcoe Street

2. That this by-law shall come into force and have effect as of third and final reading.

READ a first and second time this 13th day of July 2023.

READ a third time and finally passed this 13th day of July 2023.
