THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF WOODSTOCK BY-LAW NUMBER 9618-23

A by-law to provide for the stopping up and closing of an untravelled portion of Juliana Drive.

WHEREAS the Councils of local municipalities are authorized to pass by-laws pursuant to the provisions of Section 27(1) and 34 (1) of the *Municipal Act, S.O. 2001*, and amendments thereto, to provide for the stopping up and closing of highways;

AND WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of Woodstock deems it desirable to pass a by-law to close those parts of the highway herein described;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of The Corporation of the City of Woodstock enacts as follows:

- An untraveled portion of Juliana Drive, Part of Block 2, Plan 41M-113 designated as PARTS 1, 2 and 3 on 41R10539; and Part of Lot 27, Registrar's Compiled Plan 1600, designated as PARTS 4, 5 and 6 on 41R10539 in the City of Woodstock, in the County of Oxford, is hereby stopped up and closed.
- 2. That this by-law shall become effective as of third and final reading.
